About This Release

L'Arroye was the very first artist to record for Faces Records, and has proven to be exactly the kind of bench mark producer that Faces represents. His track 'Be The One' was the second release in 2004, and has gone on to tear up dancefloors and clubs worldwide.

In the meantime L'Arroye and keys hoodlum Ky had been building their studio, and this killer combination nailed the most eagerly anticipated broken monster of this year. The Meet steps up with snares tougher than whiplash, and amidst the filtered synths and meandering bassline there's an infectious Afro Cuban clave, twisted into the 21st century.

On the flip, L'Arroye's Be The One gets a very welcome rerub by Bedford brukateer Domu, soulfully two-stepping and shuffling it's way into your ears, with Humphrey's vocals sitting on top of the track like chocolate frosting.

This 12" has been played by all the Co-Op fam like Afronaught, Dego and IG, as well as Gilles Peterson, Benji B and Mitsu the Beats from Jazzy Sport. Domu reckons L'Aroye to be one of the best producers around at the moment.

About the Artist:

The meeting in 2002 of 2 musicians, producers. l'Aroye and Kÿ were introduced each other by Greg Musso. They started the work together around some of l'Aroye tracks. In 2003, The P600 Invasion, the 1st release of l'Aroye on Faces records contain sounds and feels of Kÿ. After a year, working together, The 2nd l'Aroye release is out titled " Be the One". It will be play listed during 3 months on the famous Radio Nova. The motivation grows up and l'Aroye and Kÿ decided to build them own studio to make music, together. After 2 months, the Chocolate studio is born in Noisy le Sec, East side of Paris. The 1st l'Aroye and Kÿ release is the "Bag u Should " remix for the label Dialect. It was playlisted on the Radio Nova between October and December 2005. Now working on different projects like hiphop, pop, electro. The Eric Rug's Tribute to my people is out and on playlist on Radio Nova. To be continued...
